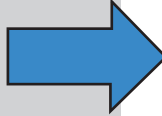

CHANGES FROM FORMER 2015 TRAINING CONCEPT

- **NO** training activities on Pagan
- **NO** extensive range footprint on Tinian (i.e., 14 live-fire ranges)
- **NO** high hazard impact areas
- **NO** use of artillery or aviation delivered munitions
- **NO** amphibious landing ramps
- **NO** activities that impede commercial air traffic



CURRENT PROPOSED TRAINING CONCEPT 2.0

- Ground training within the Military Lease Area
- 2 live-fire ranges within the Exclusive Military Use Area
- Landing zones used for aviation or ground training
- Aviation training on North Field
- Training support facilities and capabilities
