A Notice of Availability was published in the Federal Register on June 6, 2025, for the Revised Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to support land-based expeditionary ground and aviation training for all service components within lands leased by the military on Tinian. This notice announces a 15-day extension of the public comment period from June 6 to September 4, 2025.
