

PUBLIC ACCESS



- ▶ Military Lease Area would be subdivided into eight smaller training areas to allow selective closure of certain areas while allowing access in others. Cattle ranching, tourism and recreation, and subsistence activities would be allowed when such access can be safely accommodated
- ▶ The training schedule would be made available in advance by various methods
- ▶ Range Control would coordinate with Tinian officials to avoid scheduling training on holidays and other important community observances
- ▶ Temporary activation of a surface danger zone in waters north of Tinian during live-fire training at the Mutli-Purpose Maneuver Range may cause fishers and boaters to travel longer distances to access ocean waters on the west side of the island
- ▶ Shore fishing along Lamanibot Bay from Puntan Lamanibot Sanhilo (Sanhilo) to Puntan Lamanibot Papa would be restored (previously restricted due to hazards from electromagnetic radiation)
